WEATHER FORECAST OFFICE

OVERVIEW:

- Periods of snow and mixed precipitation this evening through Friday, especially north of I-90. Expected snow totals have decreased from previous updates due to mixed precipitation
- Untreated roads and surfaces may become snow covered and slick.
- Minor coastal flooding possible during the Friday morning high tide

TIMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Precipitation continues from now through Friday afternoon▪ Snow/sleet heaviest this evening, north of Route 2	
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Untreated roads/surfaces may become slick.▪ The Thursday PM commute will be impacted along the I-91 and the western Route 2 corridors▪ More widespread impacts possible to the Friday AM commute.	
NWS ALERTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Winter Weather Advisory in effect for Berkshire, Hampshire, Hampden, Franklin, Worcester, Middlesex, and Essex counties in MA and Hartford County in CT from 12 PM today to 6pm Friday.▪ Coastal Flood Advisory 5AM-12PM Friday for the eastern MA coast	
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Exact precipitation types and duration tonight into early Friday; which could impact snow totals▪ Southward extent of snowfall on Friday.	
POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Drier for much of the weekend with more seasonable temperatures.▪ Coastal low impacts us late Sunday through Monday.▪ Minor coastal flooding/splashover possible all weekend
