## Snow/Icing late Tonight-Friday



## **OVERVIEW:**

- Periods of snow and mixed precipitation this evening through Friday, especially north of I-90. Expected snow totals have decreased from previous updates due to mixed precipitation
- Untreated roads and surfaces may become snow covered and slick.
- Minor coastal flooding possible during the Friday morning high tide

HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul> <li>Untreated roads/surfaces may become slick.</li> <li>The Thursday PM commute will be impacted along the I-91 and the western Route 2 corridors</li> <li>More widespread impacts possible to the Friday AM commute.</li> </ul>	
NWS ALERTS	<ul> <li>Winter Weather Advisory in effect for Berkshire, Hampshire, Hampden, Franklin, Worcester, Middlesex, and Essex counties in MA and Hartford County in CT from 12 PM today to 6pm Friday.</li> <li>Coastal Flood Advisory 5AM-12PM Friday for the eastern MA coast</li> </ul>	
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul> <li>Exact precipitation types and duration tonight into early Friday; which could impact snow totals</li> <li>Southward extent of snowfall on Friday.</li> </ul>	
POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	<ul> <li>Drier for much of the weekend with more seasonable temperatures.</li> <li>Coastal low impacts us late Sunday through Monday.</li> <li>Minor coastal flooding/ splashover possible all weekend</li> </ul>	Expected Snowfall Totals Through Friday Afternoon
