


Important Updates

- Flood Watch issued for RI/SE MA
- Winter Storm Watch converted to a Winter \rightarrow Weather Advisory and extended southward Into the Boston to Providence corridor.
- Wind Advisory Issued for parts of southeast \rightarrow Connecticut. RI and southeast MA.
- Coastal Flood Advisory Wednesday night for \rightarrow Portions of Coastal CT.



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



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



Minor Small River & Stream Flooding Possible in Rhode Island and Southeast MA







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


