




### **Main Points**

Hazard	Impacts	Location	Timing
Wind/ Damaging Wind	Downed tree limbs and power outages possible.	Portions of Rhode Island and southeast Massachusetts.	Wednesday 9 PM though Thursday 9 AM.
Flooding =	Pockets of street flooding. Minor Small River/Stream Flooding.	Street flooding is possible across the entire region. Minor River/Stream River Flooding RI/SE MA	Tonight into Thursday.
Snow	Snow covered roads and reduced visibility.	Areas northwest of the Cape Cod Canal with impacts lasting longer across the interior.	This afternoon and evening. Snow changes to rain in most locales by midnight.
Coastal Flooding	Splashover and/or Minor Coastal Flooding	The greatest risk is along the south coast and along Narragansett Bay.	During the late evening/very early Thursday morning high tide.





### **Forecast Storm Total Snowfall**




Accumulating Snow Develops this afternoon and impacts the evening rush hour.




A period of southerly wind gusts of 40-50 mph late this evening into early Thursday morning across RI/SE MA.

## **Storm Total Precipitation**




Heavy Rain may result in pockets of street flooding Wednesday night, especially along and southeast of the Boston to Providence corridor.


Minor Small River/Stream Flooding possible across RI and SE MA into Thursday.

#### Minor Small River & Stream Flooding Possible in Rhode Island and Southeast MA










## Narragansett Bay at Fox Point

Minor Coastal Flooding Possible During the Late Wed Evening/Early Thu Timeframe




Splash-over/Minor Coastal Flooding Possible during the late Wednesday night & very early Thursday morning high tide cycle along the south coast.

Greatest risk is around Narragansett Bay, but do not expect anything more than minor coastal flooding.

#### Hourly Temperatures Valid: Thursday, January 26, 2023 at 06 AM EST



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
