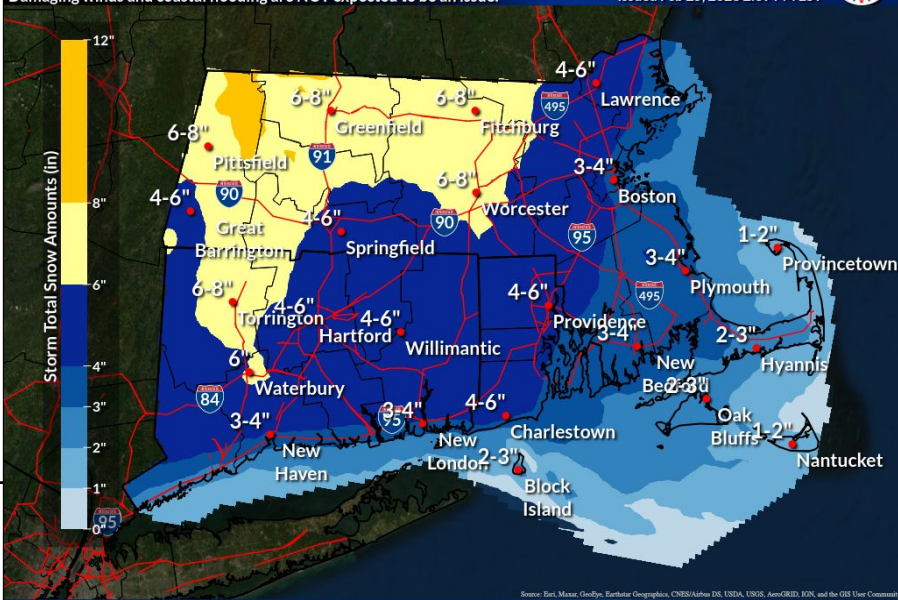
## OVERVIEW:

- Accumulating snow and/or wintry mix may affect CT, RI and MA Monday evening thru Tuesday.
- A plowable accumulation of snow is likely; highest amounts north and west of I-95.

<b>TIMING</b>	▪ Monday Night through Tuesday. Main impact Tues morning.
<b>HAZARDS &amp; IMPACTS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Potential for snow covered roads with low visibility Monday night and Tuesday.</li><li>▪ This is expected to occur after the Monday evening commute.</li><li>▪ Biggest impact would be to the Tuesday morning commute.</li></ul>
<b>NWS ALERTS</b>	▪ None at this time.
<b>FORECAST CHALLENGES</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Storm's strength and track will influence snow accumulations.</li><li>▪ Areas along the eastern and southern coastal plain may see a wintry mix for a time, which would also influence snow accumulations.</li></ul>
<b>ADDITIONAL INFORMATION</b>	▪ Damaging winds and coastal flooding will not be an issue.
<b>POST-EVENT OUTLOOK</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Seasonable temperatures Thu-Fri, but several rounds of potentially wintry weather are possible late week.</li></ul>
<b>NEXT BRIEFING</b>	▪ Sunday morning
