

## **OVERVIEW:**

- Accumulating snow Monday night into Tue, possibly mixing with or changing to rain in the coastal plain of RI & MA Tuesday
- A plowable accumulation of snow is likely; highest amounts across interior portions of MA/CT.

TIMING	<ul> <li>Monday Night through Tuesday. Heaviest snow likely Mon night.</li> <li>Snow begins 7-10PM in western MA/CT &amp; 10-2AM in eastern MA</li> </ul>		
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul> <li>Snow covered roads with low visibility Monday night into Tuesday.</li> <li>This is expected to occur after the Monday evening commute.</li> <li>Impacting the Tuesday morning commute.</li> </ul>		
NWS ALERTS	<ul> <li>Winter Storm Watches for western portions of MA/CT.</li> <li>Winter Weather Advisories for the rest of southern New England.</li> </ul>		
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul> <li>Exact storm track and strength will impact snow accumulations</li> <li>The coastal plain of RI &amp; MA may see snow mix with or change to rain Tue, which would impact snow accumulations.</li> </ul>		
ADDITIONAL INFORMATION	<ul> <li>Damaging winds and coastal flooding are <i>not</i> expected.</li> </ul>
