OVERVIEW:

- Accumulating snow Monday night into Tue, possibly mixing with or changing to rain in the coastal plain of RI & MA Tuesday
- A plowable accumulation of snow is likely; highest amounts across western portions of MA/CT.

TIMING	▪ Monday Night through Tuesday. Heaviest snow likely Mon night.	
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Snow covered roads with low visibility Monday night into Tuesday.▪ This is expected to occur after the Monday evening commute.▪ Impacting the Tuesday morning commute.	
NWS ALERTS	▪ Winter storm watches issued for western portions of MA/CT.	
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Exact storm track and strength will impact snow accumulations▪ The coastal plain of RI & MA may see snow mix with or change to rain Tue, which would impact snow accumulations.	
ADDITIONAL INFORMATION	▪ Damaging winds and coastal flooding are not expected.	
POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Dry weather returns Wednesday, along with seasonable temperatures and light winds.	<div><p>Expected Snowfall Monday night through Tuesday</p><p>Damaging winds and coastal flooding are NOT expected to be an issue.</p><p>Weather Forecast Office Boston/Norton, MA Issued Feb 26, 2023 4:32 AM EST</p><p>Area of the highest uncertainty in snowfall amounts</p></div>
