FORECAST CHALLENGES	 Still some uncertainty how far east heavy snow tracks How far north will rain-snow line track Tue afternoon? This will impact snow accumulations. 	
ADDITIONAL INFORMATION	 Damaging winds and coastal flooding are <i>not</i> expected.
