


Accumulating Snow Mar 3-4

OVERVIEW:

- Potentially impactful winter weather is possible Friday Evening into Saturday; with precipitation beginning after the PM commute
- Confidence in at least minor impacts is highest for the areas along and north of I-90. Slight shifts in storm track may increase/decrease accumulating snow potential

TIMING	▪ Friday evening into Saturday; greatest impacts between Midnight and 8 AM Saturday	
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Potential for snow/sleet/freezing rain may result in hazardous travel▪ Greatest snow accumulations above 600 ft in elevation▪ Winds in excess of 40 mph along the eastern MA coast, gusts over 50mph possible across the Cape and Islands	
NWS ALERTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Given low forecast confidence, NWS headlines are not in effect. Advisories/Watches/Warnings will be considered in future updates▪ Gale Watches are in effect for Saturday across all waters - Storm Warnings may need to be considered	
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Timing and location of greatest impacts▪ How far south will wintry precipitation be possible?	
POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	▪ Snow showers possible Sunday morning followed by dry/seasonable weather next week
