OVERVIEW:

- Increasing confidence in accumulating snow Friday Evening into Saturday; with snow accumulations beginning after the PM commute. Greatest impacts will be along and north of the I-90 corridor, with highest accumulations north of Route 2 in Massachusetts.
- Heaviest snow overnight before mixing of sleet/rain occurs after sunrise Saturday.

TIMING	▪ Friday evening into Saturday; greatest impacts between 12-8 AM Saturday.	
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Potential for snow/sleet will result in hazardous travel▪ Greatest snow accumulations north of Rte 2▪ Wind gusts up to 50 along the eastern MA coast including the Cape and Islands	
NWS ALERTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ A Winter Storm Watch is in effect for portions of MA along and west of the I-495 corridor/north of I-90.▪ Gale Warnings are in effect for the waters late Friday night-Saturday
