

OVERVIEW:

- Increasing confidence in accumulating snow Friday Evening into Saturday; with snow accumulations beginning after the PM commute. Greatest impacts will be along and north of the I-90 corridor, with highest accumulations north of Route 2 in Massachusetts.
- Heaviest snow overnight before mixing of sleet/rain occurs after sunrise Saturday.

TIMING	• Friday evening into Saturday; greatest impacts between 12-8 AM Saturday.

Potential for snow/sleet will result in hazardous travel Greatest snow accumulations north of Rte 2 **HAZARDS &** IMPACTS Wind gusts up to 50 along the eastern MA coast including the Cape and Islands
