

OVERVIEW:

NWS ALERTS

- Increasing confidence in accumulating snow Tonight into Saturday; with snow accumulations beginning after the PM commute. Greatest impacts will be along and north of the I-90 corridor, with highest accumulations north of Route 2 in Massachusetts.
- Heaviest snow overnight before mixing of sleet/rain occurs after sunrise Saturday.

TIMING	Tonight into Saturday; greatest impacts between 12-8 AM Saturday.
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	 Potential for snow/sleet will result in hazardous travel Greatest snow accumulations north of Rte 2 Wind gusts up to 55 mph along the eastern MA coast including the Cape and Islands

- A Winter Storm Warning is in effect for the areas north of I-90 away from the coast Winter Weather Advisory in effect for Suffolk, Middlesex, and Essex counties east of I-95, as well as the interior areas south of I-90, and west of I-495 away from the coast
