OVERVIEW:

- Increasing confidence in accumulating snow Tonight into Saturday; with snow accumulations beginning after the PM commute. Greatest impacts will be along and north of the I-90 corridor, with highest accumulations north of Route 2 in Massachusetts.
- Heaviest snow overnight before mixing of sleet/rain occurs after sunrise Saturday.

TIMING	▪ Tonight into Saturday; greatest impacts between 12-8 AM Saturday.	
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Potential for snow/sleet will result in hazardous travel▪ Greatest snow accumulations north of Rte 2▪ Wind gusts up to 55 mph along the eastern MA coast including the Cape and Islands	
NWS ALERTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ A Winter Storm Warning is in effect for the areas north of I-90 away from the coast▪ Winter Weather Advisory in effect for Suffolk, Middlesex, and Essex counties east of I-95, as well as the interior areas south of I-90, and west of I-495 away from the coast	
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Location of greatest impacts and timing of heaviest snow▪ How far north the snow/sleet line will be?	
POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Snow showers possible Sunday morning, followed by dry/seasonable weather to start next week
