
WEATHER FORECAST OFFICE

OVERVIEW:

- Significant Winter Storm possible Mon Night into Tue Night
- Biggest impacts likely over the interior high terrain
- More rain than snow for the I-95 corridor

TIMING	▪ Late Monday through Tuesday night
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	▪ Significant snow accumulation may result in difficult travel and snow load issues, mainly over the higher elevations of the Berkshires and Worcester Hills.
NWS ALERTS	▪ None at this time for this potential storm
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Storm's strength and track will influence snow accumulations and precipitation type. ▪ Timing of heaviest precipitation ▪ Does rain change to a period of accumulating snow near the coast
ADDITIONAL INFORMATION	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ A period of strong winds may impact the coast sometime Mon night/Tue ▪ Areas of minor coastal flooding possible during the Mon night high tide along east coastal MA.

POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Chance of snow and rain may linger into Wed ▪ Dry and seasonable Thu.
