

## OVERVIEW:

- Significant Winter Storm possible Mon Night into Tue Night
- Biggest impacts likely over the interior high terrain
- More rain than snow for the I-95 corridor

<b>TIMING</b>	▪ Late Monday through Tuesday night	
<b>HAZARDS &amp; IMPACTS</b>	▪ Significant snow accumulation may result in difficult travel and snow load issues, mainly over the higher elevations of the Berkshires and Worcester Hills.	
<b>NWS ALERTS</b>	▪ None at this time for this potential storm	
<b>FORECAST CHALLENGES</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Storm's strength and track will influence snow accumulations and precipitation type.</li> <li>▪ Timing of heaviest precipitation</li> <li>▪ Does rain change to a period of accumulating snow near the coast</li> </ul>	
<b>ADDITIONAL INFORMATION</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ A period of strong winds may impact the coast sometime Mon night/Tue</li> <li>▪ Areas of minor coastal flooding possible during the Mon night high tide along east coastal MA.</li> </ul>	
<b>POST-EVENT OUTLOOK</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Chance of snow and rain may linger into Wed</li> <li>▪ Dry and seasonable Thu.</li> </ul>	<p>Probability of Moderate Impacts From Potential Winter Storm</p> <p><b>Likelihood of Impact</b></p> <p>&lt; 5% 5% 10% 20% 30% 40% 50% 60% 70% 80% 90% &gt; 95%</p> <p><b>Potential Winter Storm Impacts</b></p> <p><b>Minor Impacts</b> Expect a few inconveniences to daily life. • Winter driving conditions. Use caution while driving.</p> <p><b>Moderate Impacts</b> Expect disruptions to daily life. • Hazardous driving conditions. Use extra caution while driving. • Closures and disruptions to infrastructure may occur.</p>
