OVERVIEW:

- Significant Winter Storm Mon Night into Wed morning.
- Greatest impacts over the interior high terrain but accumulating snow possible across the I-95 corridor into SE MA.

TIMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Monday night into Wednesday morning. ▪ Heaviest snow late Mon night into Tue evening across the high terrain. ▪ Rain changes to snow during Tue from west to east in the valleys and coastal plain and continues into Tue night.
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Significant heavy wet snow accumulation and gusty winds may result in difficult travel and power outages. ▪ Snowfall and impacts will vary greatly with elevation. ▪ Strong to damaging wind possible along E coastal MA and Cape Cod.
NWS ALERTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Winter Storm Watch expanded across SNE west of the I-95 corridor. ▪ High Wind Watch along east coastal MA from Cape Ann to Cape Cod. ▪ Gale Watches and Storm Watches over the waters
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Timing of changeover from rain to snow Tue which will impact snow accum outside of the high terrain.
ADDITIONAL INFORMATION	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Areas of minor coastal flooding possible during the Mon night, Tue and Tue night high tides along east coastal MA.
