## **OVERVIEW:**

- Significant Winter Storm Mon Night into Wed morning.
- Greatest impacts over the interior high terrain but accumulating snow possible across the I-95 corridor into SE MA.

TIMING	<ul> <li>Monday night into Wednesday morning.</li> <li>Heaviest snow late Mon night into Tue evening across the high terrain.</li> <li>Rain changes to snow during Tue from west to east in the valleys and coastal plain and continues into Tue night.</li> </ul>	
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul> <li>Significant heavy wet snow accumulation and gusty winds may result in difficult travel and power outages.</li> <li>Snowfall and impacts will vary greatly with elevation.</li> <li>Strong to damaging wind possible along E coastal MA and Cape Cod.</li> </ul>	
NWS ALERTS	<ul> <li>Winter Storm Watch expanded across SNE west of the I-95 corridor.</li> <li>High Wind Watch along east coastal MA from Cape Ann to Cape Cod.</li> <li>Gale Watches and Storm Watches over the waters</li> </ul>	
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul> <li>Timing of changeover from rain to snow Tue which will impact snow accur outside of the high terrain.</li> </ul>	n
