

	<b>HAZARDS &amp; IMPACTS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Light accumulations of snow, sleet or ice</li><li>Bridges and overpasses most vulnerable to icing</li></ul>

	<b>FORECAST CHALLENGES</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Temperatures will be critical</li><li>Daytime accumulations will be tough due to relatively warm ground</li></ul>
	<b>ADDITIONAL INFORMATION</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Precipitation trending to rain for most by Saturday afternoon.</li><li>Not overly gusty.</li><li>Elevation will be a factor to accumulating wintry precipitation</li></ul>
	<b>POST-EVENT OUTLOOK</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Becoming drier and warmer Sunday into Monday. Lows mainly in the 30s. Highs in the 50s Sunday, and 45-55 Monday.</li></ul>
	<b>NEXT BRIEFING</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>4 PM Friday, unless significant changes warrant.</li></ul>
