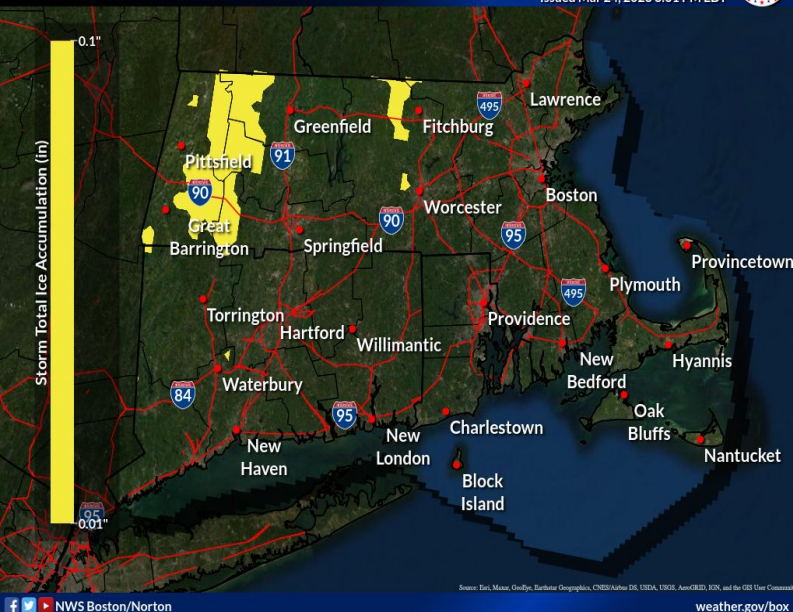

TIMING

- Saturday late morning into Saturday night

HAZARDS & IMPACTS

- Very light accumulations of snow, sleet, and freezing rain, mainly in elevations above 1,000 ft.
- Untreated roads, bridges, overpasses may be slippery

NWS ALERTS

- Special Weather Statement issued for the light icing

FORECAST CHALLENGES

- Temperatures will be critical
- Daytime accretion of ice will be tough due to relatively warm ground

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- Precipitation will be rain for most by Saturday afternoon.
- Not overly gusty... gusts up to 20 mph in higher elevations
- Elevation will be a factor for any accumulating wintry precipitation

POST-EVENT OUTLOOK

- Becoming drier and warmer Sunday into Monday. with highs in the 50s both days.
