## **OVERVIEW:**

- An approaching strong cold front may have the potential to produce briefly moderate to heavy snow, falling temps & icy roads
- Highest confidence are for areas across western Massachusetts

TIMING	<ul> <li>Late Wednesday night through early hours of Thursday</li> </ul>	
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul> <li>A strong cold front will bring the possibility of snow squalls late this evening into the early hours of Thursday.</li> <li>Snow squall may produce briefly heavy snow with falling temperatures.</li> <li>Minor snow accumulation on roadways are possible in western Massachusetts, which may lead to icy road conditions.</li> </ul>	
NWS ALERTS	<ul> <li>None at this time. In the event of a snow squall a short-fused snow squall warning may be issued to alert motorist.</li> </ul>	
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul> <li>How far east the squall line travels before diminishing. Currently, the greatest confidence is for areas of western Massachusetts.</li> </ul>	
POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	• Dry and breezy for Thursday.	Expected Snowfall - Official NWS Forecast
