# Heavy Rain Today & Tonight



## **OVERVIEW:**

- Light rain moving in this morning will become steadier & locally heavy at times late this morning into tonight, ending overnight tonight.
- Urban and poor drainage street flooding may occur, along with gradual rises on rivers, streams & waterways.

TIMING

- Steadier and heavier rains arrive into CT & western/central MA late morning to mid-afternoon (~ 11 AM to 4 PM)
- Steadier and heavier rains then shift into eastern MA and RI late this afternoon into tonight (~ 3 PM to 12 AM)
- Rain diminishes in intensity after midnight from west to east, ending early Sunday AM.

# IMPACTS

**HAZARDS &** 

- Potential for street flooding in urban and poor drainage areas.
- Slow, gradual rises on larger rivers and small creeks, perhaps to above bankfull.

## NWS ALERTS

CHALLENGES

in rain amounts increase further.

• Antecedent dry weather preceding the rain may attenuate or mitigate

• None at this time. A short-fused Flood Watch may be needed if confidence

heavy rain/hydrologic impacts.

• Where heaviest rain totals may occur: there may be two local maxima in western New England & inside of the I-95 corridor.
