OVERVIEW

- Scattered thunderstorms this evening & overnight
- Most storms should be sub-severe
- However, one or two storms may produce strong winds & localized heavy rain/flooding

TIMING

- This evening and overnight, through 8 AM Tuesday.

HAZARDS & IMPACTS

- Most storms remain sub-severe
- Strong to damaging wind gusts, which may result in localized wind damage
- Downpours leading to localized flooding

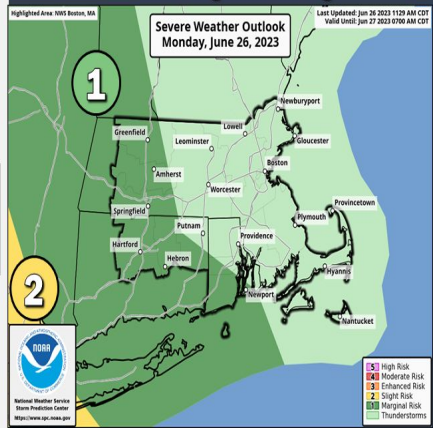
WHAT THIS MEANS:

ISOLATED SEVERE STORMS This Evening & Overnight



What To Expect

- Localized strong to damaging wind gusts are possible, which could cause isolated tree damage.

What To Do?

- Stay Weather Aware!
- Check back should the forecast change
- Be ready to take shelter indoors when storms approach
- Have multiple ways to receive warnings



NWS ALERTS

- None at this time

FORECAST CHALLENGES

- **What we know** - there will be scattered thunderstorms tonight with most storms remaining sub-severe
- **What we don't know** - will all storms be sub-severe?

POST-EVENT OUTLOOK

- Muggy with daily chances for PM showers & thunderstorms. Locally heavy downpours possible each day.
- An isolated strong to severe storms not out of question Tuesday, including Tue.AM, but more likely west of New England in NY state.
