

Isolated Severe Storms Today & Tonight



OVERVIEW

- Hit or miss thunderstorms develop this afternoon
- A line of showers & thunderstorms move into southern New England late tonight
- Some of the storms could become strong to severe, and there is a risk for localized flooding.

TIMING

- First round from noon until 6 PM for areas west of I-495
- Second round is after 9 PM for much of southern New England

HAZARDS & IMPACTS

- Strong to damaging wind gusts, which may result in localized tree and powerline damage
- Downpours leading to localized flooding
- Large hail

NWS ALERTS

- None at this time

FORECAST CHALLENGES

- While several thunderstorms are likely with the first round of storms, the severe weather risk may be limited.
- Uncertain how strong the second round of storms may be and if they will maintain strength to the eastern coast.

POST-EVENT OUTLOOK

- Muggy with daily chances for PM showers & thunderstorms. Locally heavy downpours possible each day.
- Strong to severe storms not out of question Tuesday, but will be dependent on how quickly storms tonight move through
