

Excessive Rainfall and Flash Flooding Possible Today

WEATHER FORECAST OFFICE

OVERVIEW:

- Heavy rainfall with embedded thunderstorms may result in localized flash flooding today
- Risk is exacerbated over portions of central CT and MA where heavy rainfall fell yesterday evening

TIMING & LOCATION

- Today between 11am and 8pm.
- Mainly south of I-90

HAZARDS & IMPACTS

- Excessive rainfall leading to flash flooding
- Small streams and urban/poor drainage areas will be particularly susceptible
- Frequent cloud to ground lightning

NWS ALERTS

- Flood Watch in effect through 2am Wednesday

FORECAST CHALLENGES

- Areal coverage and intensity of storms producing excessive rainfall
- Is there potential for an isolated strong to severe storm capable of producing damaging wind gusts?

POST-EVENT OUTLOOK

- Drier conditions on Wednesday but with hot and humid conditions
