

OVERVIEW: <ul style="list-style-type: none">Heavy rainfall expected Sunday into Monday, with up to 3 inches with locally higher amounts possible.Slow moving thunderstorms with heavy downpours may lead to localized flash floodingGreatest risk Sunday along and west of I-91 including the Hartford area, then across most of Southern New England on Monday	
TIMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Rain with thunderstorms Sunday, mainly into western sections of CT and MA.Rain will expand in coverage Sunday night into Monday.
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Persistent excessive rains may cause rapid-onset localized flash flooding, as well as flooding of urban and poor drainage areas.Rivers and streams may rise to over bankfull in the face of excessive rain, leading to flooding along rivers during & after cessation of excessive rains.
NWS ALERTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">None at this time. <u>However a Flood Watch may be needed for parts of Southern New England pending prior days' rain and as confidence increases.</u>
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Moderate confidence on heaviest rain locations, but low confidence on the amounts. There may be localized higher totals under persistent storms.Areas most susceptible to flooding will be influenced by previous days' rain, which is uncertain.
POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	<ul style="list-style-type: none">Wet/unsettled weather continues Monday night into Tuesday morning
