Heavy Rainfall Sunday/Monday



OVERVIEW:

- Heavy rainfall expected Sunday into Monday, with up to 3 inches with locally higher amounts possible.
- Slow moving thunderstorms with heavy downpours may lead to localized flash flooding
- Greatest risk Sunday along and west of I-91 including the Hartford area, then across most of Southern New England on Monday

TIMING

- Rain with thunderstorms Sunday, mainly into western sections of CT and MA.
- Rain will expand in coverage Sunday night into Monday.

HAZARDS &

IMPACTS

- Persistent excessive rains may cause rapid-onset localized flash flooding, as well as flooding of urban and poor drainage areas.
- Rivers and streams may rise to over bankfull in the face of excessive rain, leading to flooding along rivers during & after cessation of excessive rains.

 None at this time. However a Flood Watch may be needed for parts of Southern New England pending prior days' rain and as confidence

NWS ALERTS

- Moderate confidence on heaviest rain locations, but low confidence on the amounts. There may be localized higher totals under persistent storms.
- Areas most susceptible to flooding will be influenced by previous days' rain, which is uncertain.


