OVERVIEW:

- Showers and thunderstorms later today into Friday morning may cause flooding of urban areas and small streams.
- Locations at greatest risk of flooding includes northern CT, all of RI, and western, central, and part of southeast MA.
- Additionally, a line of storms moving into western MA tonight could produce wind damage and hail in a few locations.

TIMING	▪ Later today through Friday morning.	
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Rainfall totals of half inch to one inch, with localized amounts of 3+ inches under heavier downpours in the Flood Watch area.▪ Given the saturated ground and swollen rivers/streams, it won't take as much rain as it typically would to see flooding issues.	
NWS ALERTS	▪ Flood Watch for northern CT, all of RI, and western, central, and part of southeast MA.	
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Areal coverage of the heaviest downpours and flooding concerns.▪ Does urban flooding impact the Friday AM commute?	
POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Unsettled weather pattern with showers and t-storms continues for the weekend.
