- Isolated severe thunderstorms with the main risk of damaging wind gusts. There is also a low risk of a brief tornado.

Sunday morning through Sunday evening.

• Urban, street and basement flooding, as well as rapid rises on rivers, creeks and streams. Considerable flooding may result in inundation in homes and **HAZARDS & IMPACTS** businesses with road washouts possible. Localized damaging wind gusts possible. Trees may be more vulnerable given saturated grounds.


FORECAST CHALLENGES

 Flood Watch for much of southern New England late tonight through late Sunday night. Areal coverage of the heaviest downpours and flooding concerns.

Wind damage from thunderstorms as saturated ground may make

trees more vulnerable to fall. Activity may be less widespread Sunday afternoon.

Dry for much of Mon, but hot & humid. Scattered **POST-EVENT** OUTLOOK shower & thunderstorm chances return Tue.
