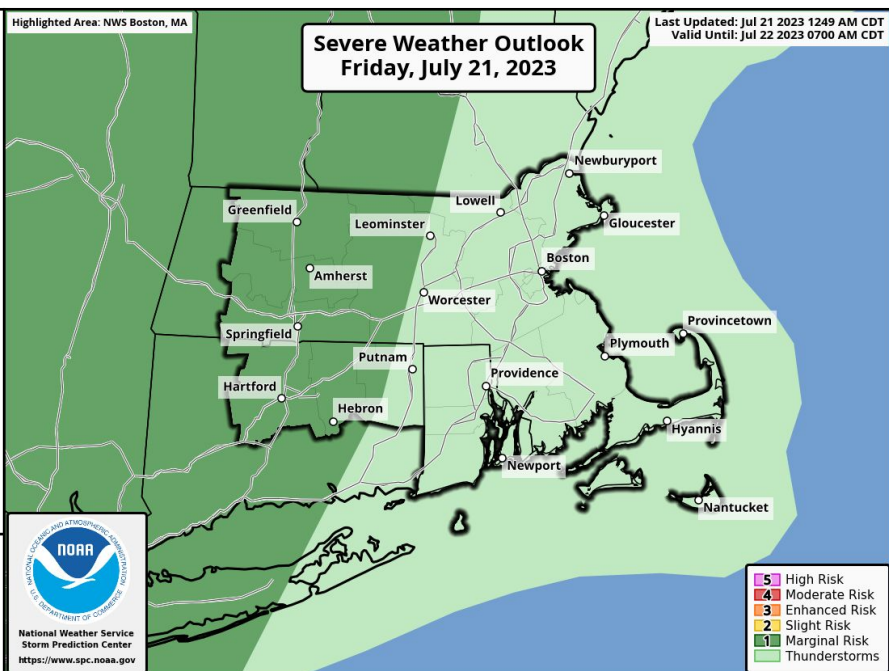

WEATHER FORECAST OFFICE

OVERVIEW:

- Showers and thunderstorms Friday afternoon/evening will produce localized rainfall rates exceeding 1 inch/hr which may lead to localized flash flooding, mainly across central/W MA and N CT
- Some storms may also be severe, producing localized wind damage and hail

TIMING	▪ Friday afternoon and evening
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Localized flash flooding of urban and poor drainage areas▪ Localized damaging wind gusts and hail
NWS ALERTS	▪ None at this time
FORECAST CHALLENGES	▪ Areal coverage of strongest storms and heaviest rainfall, including how far east storms track
POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Dry weather & lower humidity returns this weekend
