NWS Boston Monday EM Briefing

Key Messages

- Dangerous heat expected Thursday through Saturday with heat indices ranging from 95 to 104 degrees each afternoon
 - Heat Advisory in effect 11 AM Thursday 8 PM Friday
 - Advisory will likely be extended into Saturday
- Scattered strong to severe thunderstorms expected tomorrow afternoon and evening
 - Damaging straight lines winds are the most like hazard
 - Also a risk for large hail and tornadoes
 - Storms most likely between 2 and 10 pm
- Excessive rainfall and recent wetness may lead to localized flash flooding
 - Flood Watch in effect Thursday morning through Thursday evening for most of MA
 - Flood Watch may need to be extended further south










Heat Advisory Thursday - Friday

Max Heat Indices up to 104 degrees






Severe Weather Outlook

Slight Risk Category for Thursday (Slight Risk is a 2 on a Scale of 1-5)


Thursday Severe Wind Probability 15-29% Chance






Large Hail and Tornado Risk
