OVERVIEW:

- Isolated to Scattered Severe Thunderstorms Tuesday morning and again Tuesday afternoon
- Main threats are damaging wind gusts and heavy downpours, which may lead to urban flooding. There is also a risk for brief tornado or waterspout

TIMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Round 1 - Tuesday between daybreak and noon; risk for tornadoes highest during this period▪ Round 2 - Tuesday afternoon	
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Heavy downpours may impact Tuesday morning commute with localized flash flooding of urban and poor drainage areas.▪ Damaging winds and a low risk for a brief tornado or waterspout.	
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Areal coverage of strongest storms and heaviest rainfall.▪ Strength of afternoon storms and severe potential hinges on early morning convection	
POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Dry weather Wednesday with seasonable temps.▪ Turning unsettled late in the week.
