

OVERVIEW:

- Friday will feature a round of strong to severe storms in the morning and afternoon
- Main hazards are damaging winds, large hail, and flash flooding, with a lower but still present risk of tornadoes.

TIMING	▪ Friday morning and afternoon. Bulk of the storms should move offshore by 5-6 PM.	
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	▪ Main hazards are damaging winds, large hail, and flash flooding, with a lower but still present risk of tornadoes.	
NWS ALERTS	▪ None at this time.	
FORECAST CHALLENGES	▪ Areal coverage of strongest storms and location of heaviest rainfall.	
POSTEVENT OUTLOOK	▪ Cooler and drier air arrives Friday night into Saturday.
