

# Flooding & Severe Storms Possible Wed

## OVERVIEW:

- 1 to 2 inches of rain with isolated totals up to 4 inches in a short period may lead to flooding of streams & urban areas.
- Isolated severe storms possible as well. Main risk is damaging winds & a brief tornado cannot be ruled out.

<b>TIMING</b>	▪ 11 AM to 7 PM
<b>HAZARDS &amp; IMPACTS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Wet antecedent conditions combined with heavy downpours may result in flooding rivers/streams &amp; flooding of urban areas</li><li>▪ Damaging winds &amp; a low risk for a brief tornado</li></ul>
<b>NWS ALERTS</b>	▪ Flood Watch for much of Southern New England
<b>FORECAST CHALLENGES</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Where the heaviest rain occurs</li><li>▪ Areal coverage of strongest storms</li></ul>
<b>POST-EVENT OUTLOOK</b>	<div><div><div>Flash Flooding Possible</div><div>Do Not Drive Through Flooded Roads Or Underpasses</div><div></div></div><div><div>Weather Forecast Office Boston/Norton, MA Issued Sep 12, 2023 3:47 PM EDT</div><div><b>Flood Watch</b> In effect 11 AM Wednesday through 7 AM Thursday</div><div><ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Rainfall of 1 to 2 inches, isolated higher amounts up to 4 inches are possible.</li><li>• Rapid-onset flash flooding is possible.</li><li>• Flooding may be locally significant where persistent downpours develop and especially areas that have seen severe flooding.</li></ul></div></div></div> <div>▪ Drier &amp; cooler Thursday</div>
