## **OVERVIEW:**

- I to 2 inches of rain with isolated totals up to 4 inches in a short period may lead to flooding of streams & urban areas.
- Isolated severe storms possible as well. Main risk is damaging winds
   & a brief tornado cannot be ruled out.

Wet antecedent conditions combined with heavy downpours may result in flooding rivers/streams & flooding of urban areas
