


## OVERVIEW:

- 1 to 3 inches of snow are expected across the high elevations of the Berkshires and Worcester Hills Tuesday night, before changing to rain. Up to 4" possible for the high terrain of the Berkshires
- Strong winds Wednesday across the Cape and Islands

<b>TIMING</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Snow between 8-10PM Tuesday and 4-6AM Wednesday</li><li>▪ Strong winds between 5AM and 4PM Wednesday</li></ul>	
<b>HAZARDS &amp; IMPACTS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ A period of snow will lead to accumulations of 1 to 4 inches before changing to rain</li><li>▪ Wind gusts of 30-50 mph along the coast with strongest winds across Cape Cod and the Islands.</li></ul>	
<b>NWS ALERTS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Gale Warning for all waters Tuesday night and Wednesday.</li><li>▪ Wind Advisory is in place for the Cape and Islands Wednesday</li><li>▪ Winter Weather Advisory for western Franklin and Hampshire Counties</li></ul>	
<b>FORECAST CHALLENGES</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Marginal temperatures and uncertainty on the track of the storm lead to uncertainty as to how much snow accumulates before being washed away by rain.</li><li>▪ Whether the strongest wind gusts (50+mph) materialize over Cape Cod</li></ul>
