

High Elevation Snow Tonight



WEATHER FORECAST OFFICE

OVERVIEW:

- 1 to 3 inches of snow are expected across the high elevations of the Berkshires and Worcester Hills tonight, before changing to rain. Up to 4" possible for the high terrain of the Berkshires
- Strong winds Wednesday along the coasts, and especially across the Cape and Islands, as well as Cape Ann

TIMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Snow between 7-10 PM Tonight and then ending 2-5 AM Wednesday▪ Strong winds between 5 AM and 4 PM Wednesday west to east	
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ A period of snow will lead to accumulations of 1 to 4 inches before changing to rain▪ Wind gusts of 30-50 mph along the coast with strongest winds across Cape Cod and the Islands.	
NWS ALERTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Gale Warning for all waters Tonight and Wednesday.▪ Wind Advisory is in place for the Cape and Islands and Cape Ann Wed▪ Winter Weather Advisory for western Franklin and western Hampshire Counties	
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Marginal temperatures and uncertainty on the timing of warmer air arriving lead to uncertainty as to how much snow accumulates before being washed away by rain.	
POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Dry, cooler, and breezy conditions return for Thanksgiving.▪ Much Colder Temperatures Saturday
