- Wind Advisory issued for the south coast of MA and Plymouth County










## **Rainfall Forecast**

- Minor street flooding for the Monday morning commute




### **Snowfall Forecast**

## **River Flood Outlook**



 Minor river flooding is likely (greater than 60%) Monday along and near the mainstem Connecticut River. There is a lower probability a few spots could experience moderate flooding

(Orange circles = 30% chance)



## **Coastal Flooding**

#### **Total Water Level Forecast: Providence**



Minor: flooding less than one foot deep Moderate: flooding 1 to 2 feet deep

- Minor flooding most likely early Monday morning along south coastal MA/RI.
- Close to Moderate flooding on the upper end of Narragansett Bay including Providence.

# **Threat Event Summary**

Confidence: Moderate (60%) on a high impact storm





Downed trees/power lines from 40-60 mph winds, strongest coast



Minor to moderate coastal flooding along south coastal MA/RI



Minor river/stream flooding in CT and western MA



Dangerous conditions for marine vessels Sun night into Mon
