



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

Rainfall Forecast





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
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Heaviest rain Sunday night into early Monday morning Minor street flooding for the Monday morning commute



Snowfall Forecast







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
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Rain should change to snow Monday in and near the **Berkshires** Accumulations should be limited to the higher elevations

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
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Minor river flooding is possible Monday along and near the mainstem Connecticut River


