








Max Wind Gusts


Wind Gusts will peak Monday Morning








Forecast Rain Totals

- Minor to Moderate river flooding is possible
- Greatest Risk for Moderate River Flooding is in the CT River Valley



Coastal Flooding

Total Water Level Forecast: Providence



Minor: flooding less than one foot deep Moderate: flooding 1 to 2 feet deep

- High confidence for at least Minor Coastal Flooding surrounding the Monday mid-day high tide, with the potential for Moderate Coastal Flooding in Narragansett Bay
- Lower risk of minor flooding/splash over along the rest of RI/MA south and east coasts







Coastal Flood Forecast

High Confidence in impacts from Minor Coastal Flooding with potential Moderate Coastal Flooding in Narragansett Bay

Flood threat is contingent on the Monday lunchtime high tide coinciding with the timing of highest southeast winds.







Threat Event Summary

Confidence: High (80%) on a high impact storm

➤ What:



Downed trees/power lines from 40-60 mph winds, strongest coast



Minor to moderate river/stream flooding. Significant street flooding likely



Minor to moderate coastal flooding, especially along Narragansett Bay



Dangerous conditions for marine vessels Sun evening through Monday

- **>>** Where: All of southern New England (CT, MA, and RI)
- When: Overnight Sunday into Monday
