



OVERVIEW:

- Impactful winter storm possible late Saturday into Sunday
- Still uncertain on the exact track and intensity of the system
- The combination of heavy wet snow and gusty winds near the rain/snow line will bring the potential for power outages

HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Hazardous driving conditions ▪ Potential for power outages

FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Still uncertainty in the track and intensity of the system. Honing in on these details will be key for determining specific amounts, precipitation types and impacts to the region. ▪ Where exactly the rain/snow line sets up will determine where the heavy wet snow risk is highest.
