→ As of 430 PM Thursday, January 4th 2024




Important Updates

- → Winter Storm Watch in effect for locations north and west of I-95
- → "Plowable" snow, 3-6"+, likely southern New England. Up to 12 inches possible
- → Snow to begin after 6 PM Saturday and end by 6 PM Sunday
- → Precipitation Type Issues will plague the I-95 corridor/coastline







Probability of Snowfall Exceedance







Probability of Snowfall Exceedance



Expected Snowfall Forecast


