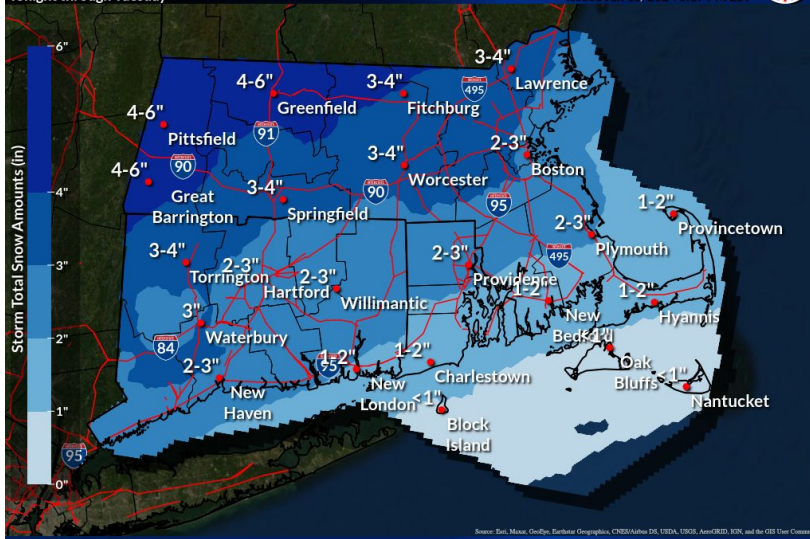
- Accumulating snow late tonight into Tue, highest accum interior MA
- Snow changes to a period of sleet and freezing rain a bit west of I-95 corridor, and to plain rain south and east of I-95

TIMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Snow begins by midnight south coast, reaching N MA by 3 AM▪ Snow changes to sleet/freezing rain after noon from NE CT, N RI into NE MA, and to all rain 9 AM to noon along and south and east of I-95▪ Precipitation ends by Tue evening
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Snow covered roads will impact Tue AM commute▪ Snow covered and icy roads may impact areas north and west of I-95 during the evening commute.
NWS ALERTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Winter Weather Advisories for all SNE, except for SE MA and Cape/Islands
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Still some uncertainty how far inland rain-ice-snow line advances▪ Highest confidence in all snow BDL-ORH-LWM north and west
POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Blustery and cold Wed and Thu▪ Another storm may impact the region Fri and Fr night
