

Accumulating Snow Fri-Fri Night



WEATHER FORECAST OFFICE

OVERVIEW:

- Accumulating snow midday Friday into Friday night
- May impact the Friday evening commute in far SE MA

TIMING	▪ Accumulating snow begins after lunchtime Friday and tapers off late Friday night. Some light snow showers could linger on the outer Cape on Saturday morning	
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	▪ Snow covered roads may impact the evening commute across far southeast MA	
NWS ALERTS	▪ None at this time; Given recent downward trends in snow totals, an advisory may be considered for only Plymouth and Barnstable counties in future updates.	
FORECAST CHALLENGES	▪ Will dry air eat away at the northeastern edge of the snow shield? ▪ An unlikely, but possible solution yields up to 4 or 5" of snow in localized areas of southern Plymouth County and the Upper Cape due to ocean enhancement	
POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	▪ Frigid and windy with potentially dangerous wind chills in a few spots ▪ Freezing spray over the waters
