

OVERVIEW:

- Light snow, mainly 1-2” but up to 3” in the Berkshires
- Pockets of light freezing rain/freezing drizzle Wednesday across central/W MA and CT, except along the south coast

TIMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Light snow will diminish before daybreak with pockets of light freezing rain/drizzle developing Wed in the interior, especially higher terrain.▪ Temps rise above freezing in the interior during the afternoon
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Untreated roads become snow covered and slippery tonight, with slippery travel lingering Wed in the interior..
NWS ALERTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Winter Weather Advisory for central/W MA and much of CT, except for the south coast.
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Extent of light freezing rain on Wednesday and how long sub-freezing temperatures linger across the interior
POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Periods of rain Thursday into the first part of Friday with temps above freezing in all locations.
