

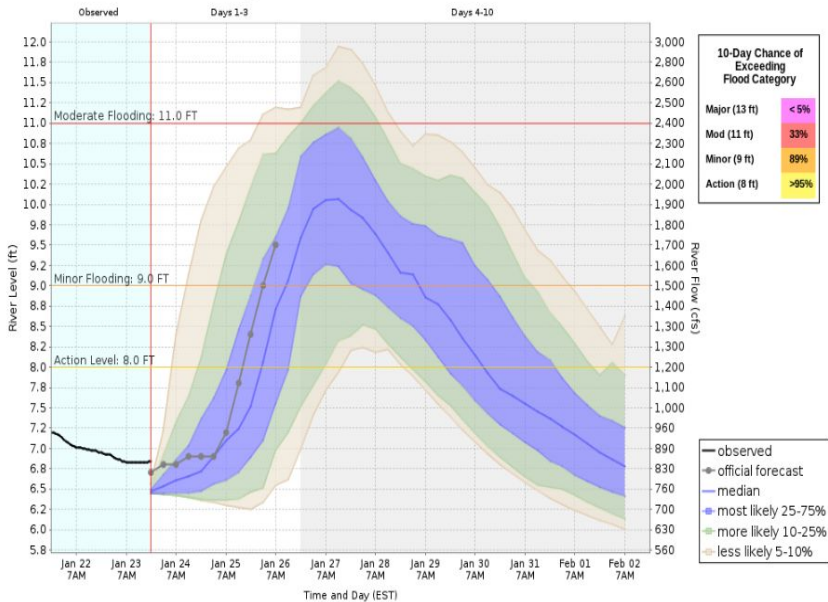


OVERVIEW:

- Rainfall Thursday into Friday may cause flooding of urban areas and some rivers, including the Pawtuxet River.
- Flooding is not expected to be as significant as what occurred earlier this month.

TIMING	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Flooding of urban areas Thursday into Friday.▪ Rivers may flood Thursday evening into the weekend, especially the Pawtuxet River, which could crest near its moderate flood stage Saturday.
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Flooding of urban areas and low lying areas near rivers.
NWS ALERTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Flood Watch for RI.
FORECAST CHALLENGES	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Where the heaviest rain falls will determine the extent of flooding. It is not certain that RI will receive the heaviest rain.
POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Dry weather follows Friday and Saturday with above normal temperatures. Rain likely returns Sunday.
