

OVERVIEW:

- More rain tonight into Friday may cause flooding of some rivers, especially the Pawtuxet River and Wood River.
- Flooding will not be as significant as what occurred earlier this month.

TIMING	 Pawtuxet River reaches flood stage early tonight and crests just below its Moderate flood stage Friday into Saturday. Wood River reaches Minor flood stage early Friday morning. 		
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	 Flooding of low lying areas near rivers. 		
NWS ALERTS	 Flood Watch for RI. 		
FORECAST CHALLENGES	 Where the heaviest rain falls will determine the level of flooding. It is not certain that RI will receive the heaviest rain, thus minor flooding is most likely to occur.
