

WEATHER FORECAST OFFICE

OVERVIEW:

- Coastal storm Sunday into Monday brings higher elevation snow, & lower elevation snow/rain changing to snow Sunday night.
- Greatest accumulations more favored in the higher terrain.
- Impacts to travel Sunday and for the Monday commutes.

TIMING	▪ Sunday into Monday. Period of greatest accumulation Sunday evening into early Monday.	
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Snow covered roads and difficult travel Sunday into Monday, even in lower elevations.▪ Isolated snow load concerns due to weight of wet snow, especially in the higher terrain where greatest accumulation expected.▪ Splashover or very minor coastal flooding around high tide(s) late Sunday night, possibly for Monday afternoon as well.	
NWS ALERTS	▪ Winter Storm Watches for the Berkshires, northern Worcester County and northwest Middlesex County Sunday into Monday.	
FORECAST CHALLENGES	▪ Rain mixing in and timing of changeover from rain to snow may affect snow accumulations. Greatest uncertainty in snow accumulations in lower elevations because of these factors.
