- Increasing confidence for a Winter Storm to impact the region, with the potential for significant snowfall
- Large uncertainty still exists regarding exact track and intensity of the storm, so it's difficult to determine specific details

HAZARDS & IMPACTS	 Potential for significant snowfall accumulations Potential for coastal flooding during times of high tide 		
NWS ALERTS	 None at this time, given the uncertainty with the forecast 		
FORECAST CHALLENGES	 Storm track and strength will have a big role in what we see. A northerly track over southern New England will produce more rain than snow. A track south of the region will bring snow everywhere, even along the coast. A further south track would only produce light snow along the south coastal areas.
