OVERVIEW:

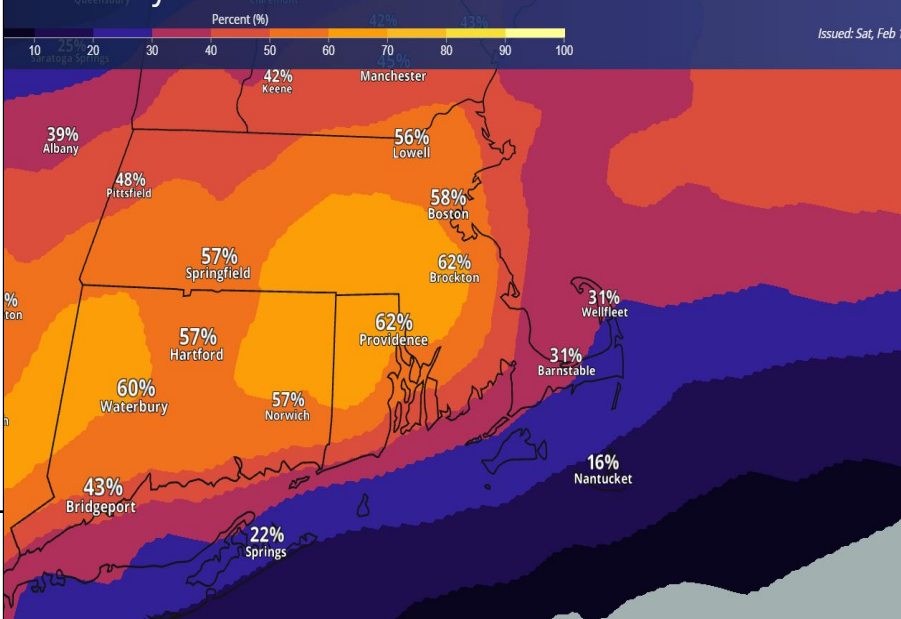
- Increasing confidence for a Winter Storm to impact the region, with significant snowfall possible
- Uncertainty still exists regarding the track & intensity of the storm, so it is difficult to determine specific details

TIMING	▪ Monday Night through Tuesday
HAZARDS & IMPACTS	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Snow covered roads & difficult travel possible Monday Night through Tuesday. Could have issues for the Tuesday AM & PM commutes.▪ Potential for coastal flooding
NWS ALERTS	▪ None at this time
FORECAST CHALLENGES	▪ Storm track & strength remain a challenge. A northerly track would produce more rain than snow. A track south of the region will bring snow everywhere, even along the coast. A further offshore track would only produce light snow along the south coastal areas.
POST-EVENT OUTLOOK	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Generally dry, blustery with near to below normal temperatures Wed thru Fri.
