


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
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Forecast Storm Total Snowfall



Probabilities of Moderate Impacts from Snow Loading (WSSI)





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Probability of Exceeding 12"





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

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

Coastal Flood Forecast



Minor to moderate coastal flooding anticipated across the eastern Massachusetts coastline.

High tide of greatest concern is the **Tuesday** afternoon high tide, but there could still be lingering issues for the Wednesday morning high tide.

- The eastern Massachusetts coast is particularly vulnerable given the coastal
- Storm surge of 2.5 to 3.5 feet anticipated.



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
